1. Prizes

2. Application eligibility

1. The Yangtze River Junior Piano Competition is open to pianists who are New Zealand citizens, New Zealand permanent residents and those who have studied for at least two years in New Zealand.

- 2. Applicants must be born after 1 July 2005.
- 3. Full-time university performance students are not eligible.
- 3. Audition
- 1. The camera angle must remain unchanged and the video cannot be edited.
- 2. The applicant's face and hands have to be clearly visible.
- 3. Audition programme: 5-10 minutes programme of your choice
- 4. Applications must be received prior to applications close date.
- 5. Late applications will not be accepted.
- 6. Competitors will be notified of acceptance one month after applications close date.

4. Repertoire

- 1. Competitors will perform a 3-10minute recital programme of their choice.
- 2. No changes to the programme are permitted after Final Repertoire Programme deadline.

3. Results will be announced at the conclusion of the session. The adjudication decision is final and beyond appeal.

5. Adjudication

- 1. The adjudicator is yet to be announced.
- 3. Results will be announced at 26th September
- 4. The adjudicator reserves the right not to award any prize.

6. Performance rights

Rights to any competition performance, whether broadcast, televised, or recorded belong to the competition and no fee is payable for any transmissions, recordings or broadcasts of them.

7. Publicity

1. All applicants must submit:

• Photograph – a digital colour photograph (hi res, minimum 300dpi) of head and shoulders for publicity purposes.

• Biography – a biography of not more than 50 words in electronic file format.

2. The competition has the right to reproduce this information in publicity or programme notes. Competitors may be interviewed for publicity purposes. Competitors must waive the right to review any material used and will receive no remuneration for use of this material.
